## **What is the "B-SAFE Workshop Video?"**

This 'one of a kind' video is a unique creation of Community Partners 4 Kids, produced by TV Marketing & Promotions of Emmaus, Pa., to educate children and youth, and their parents, on the threats to their safety by violent predators of all types and how these kids can avoid or escape safely, on their own, without the help of an adult.

## **Why was this created?**

The United States Department of Justice advises that of all of the 'failed' attempts to attack or abduct a child, 86.4% failed because the child had been educated about the danger and how to avoid becoming a victim. Overwhelming evidence of the need for safety education for our children.

## **What are some of the topics covered in the video?**

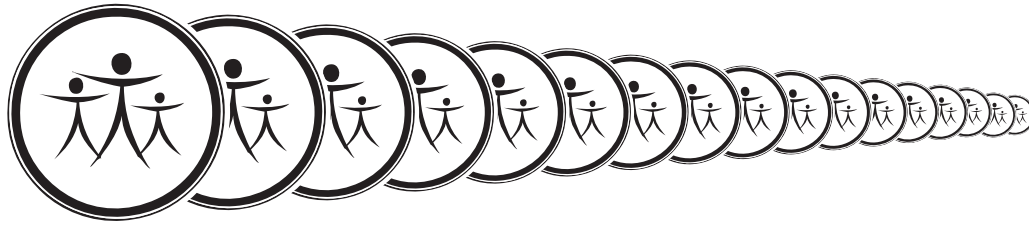
"Basic Safety Tips", "Safety at School", "Social Media & Internet Safety", "Drug & Alcohol Abuse Prevention & Recovery", "Sex Trafficking", "Family Safety Planning", "Personal Safety and Self-Defense", "What is Child Abuse and How to Deal with It".

Well-known local and regional experts have joined in this effort to make sure your kids will recognize danger and make the right choices to safely avoid victimization.

## **How does this work? How do I get it for our organi- zation?**

The "B-SAFE Workshop Video" is delivered to organizations through a licensing agreement issued for an annual basis. Community Partners 4 Kids has created this video, which currently has eight different segments, and is intended to be viewed at one time in its entirety or it can also be viewed in segments for time management purposes.





**How long is the license period?**

Licenses are issued for the period of September 1, thru June 30, or the entire school year. Since the initial launch of the B-SAFE program is scheduled for March 20, 2018, the initial license will cover April 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

**License fees are as follows:**

Organizations with registered members of less than 200 will pay an annual license fee of \$200.00.

Organizations with registered members of 200 or more will pay an annual license fee of \$1.00 per member.

Community Partners 4 Kids will provide each Licensee with the following in return for its License fee:

1. Two (2) copies of the video on DVD (More available, if needed – subject to terms of License Agreement).
2. Digital files on a flash drive of:
  - a) List of online resources for parents
  - b) List of local law enforcement contacts
  - c) List of local resources for treating various issues
  - d) Other related resources
  - e) Digital copy of the Child Safety Handbook

Although the digital copy of the Child Safety Handbook is protected by Copyright law, the license to use the B-SAFE Workshop Video also allows the licensee the right to share the “Child Safety Handbook” with its members.
